Official Rules

- I. **ENTRY:** Graduating seniors from Louisiana high schools are invited to participate in Gordon's Grads, presented by Gordon McKernan Injury Attorneys under its charity arm, Gordon Gives. To enter, applicants must complete the registration form and requirements on www.gordonsgrads.com by Thursday, April 30, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. CST.

By submitting a nomination, participants agree to abide by these Official Rules and acknowledge the decisions of Gordon McKernan Injury Attorneys, which are final and binding.

- II. **ELIGIBILITY:** Gordon's Grads is open to seniors graduating from Louisiana high schools in the Spring of 2026 and attending a college or trade school during the Fall of 2026. All applicants must provide proof of enrollment into a college or trade school in the Fall of 2026 upon registration. All eligible applicants will be considered without regard to race, sex, religion, or national origin.

All essays will be scanned using AI detection tools. Any submission found to be generated by AI will be automatically disqualified.

- IV. **SELECTION:** The selection process will be conducted by a scholarship committee appointed by Gordon McKernan Injury Attorneys. Each submission will be thoroughly reviewed and evaluated based on the following criteria: relevance to prompt, clarity and coherence, creativity and originality, impact and persuasiveness.
